Being dependent on God, we inspire and equip at-risk youth and their families to lead healthy and responsible lives through family-centered care, treatment and education.

2021 IN REVIEW

Expanding & Growing Our Counseling Services

Rawhide is a leading mental and behavioral health agency with its 8 counseling centers across the state of Wisconsin. The crucial therapy services we provide help youth survive their mental health struggles with anxiety, depression and suicidal thoughts after experiencing trauma, abuse and neglect.

We are now the leading equine-assisted therapy provider in Wisconsin. In 2021, we expanded our equine-assisted therapy by adding three additional facilities to touch the lives of even more Wisconsin youth.

Our equine-assisted therapy sessions give youth the opportunity to connect with, and participate in, activities and games with our therapy horses. Building these special bonds with the equine while working with our licensed therapists help youth feel more comfortable opening up about their trauma in a safe judgment-free environment.



First, we opened our brand new, state-of-the-art Fond du Lac Counseling Center, complete with two arenas, six therapy rooms, 12 horse stalls and 7 therapists (including 1 occupational therapist). Embedding ourselves into this community allows us a chance to be a steady rock for the youth and families in Fond du Lac that are struggling with mental health.

Second, we partnered with BEAMING, Inc. in Neenah, which is a facility that offers a horse riding program to serve those with disabilities and special needs. With this new partnership, we are now able to offer critical, life-saving, equine-assisted mental health therapy services to the Neenah, Oshkosh and Fox Cities communities. This partnership between BEAMING and Pawbide laverages BEAMING's therapy borses and handlers

Third, we partnered with MKE Urban Stables to offer equine-assisted therapy three days a week to the Milwaukee community leveraging 12 horse stalls, an equine arena and a therapy room. With this partnership, Rawhide is able to provide a therapy option that is not often offered in an urban setting. MKE Urban Stables also houses the Milwaukee Police Department's mounted patrol horses and provides therapy for veterans in the community.



Career Development Class

In partnership with Goodwill NCW and the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR), Rawhide and Goodwill developed a co-branded career development class for youth in our residential care and group home programs to help improve their chances of workplace readiness and success. The course content was created with a trauma-informed, therapeutic lens to best meet the needs of our youth. The curriculum covers essential skills, such as managing workplace conflict and staying motivated. Career preparation is also a large portion of the class where youth learn how to create resumes, interview, research careers and more.

Staff Appreciation Day with Chris Kroeze

Our friends at Bernatello's Foods helped us celebrate our Staff Appreciation Day in August with delicious Brew Pub Pizza and live country music entertainment from Chris Kroeze, a runner-up on season 15 of "The Voice!" Staff enjoyed country-themed games, food and dancing. The youth even joined in the fun for their own concert with Chris!






QRTP Certification & CARE Model Training

We are one of the first organizations in Wisconsin to receive a Qualified Residential Treatment Program (QRTP) certification through the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families (DCF)!

This means that we follow 5 standardized qualifications to ensure we are providing the highest quality residential and group home care to our youth.



One of the requirements is to implement an evidence-based, trauma-informed care model for treatment. Rawhide is currently training all employees using Cornell University's Children And Residential Experiences (CARE) Model. It is a principle-based model that provides six principles to guide decision making, considering the best interest of the children and families served.



Fish Fries Return We brought our Fish Fries back!

Our capacity doubled in 2021, thanks to the additional space in our newly renovated Café 15. We served 1,194 people thanks to our 187 staff and youth helpers and 37 volunteers.

BUILDING HOPE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN KICKOFF

We kicked off our Building Hope Capital Campaign at The Main Event Gala in 2021. Most ambitious capital campaigns, similar to ours, take years to raise the necessary funds to complete the projects. But thanks to the incredible support of our partners we have gained over the years, we were able to meet our \$6 million goal in less than one year!

With the funding from this campaign, we were able to expand the capacity of our residential services with the addition of the new Starr Youth Home that was completed in early 2022.

We have also begun construction on our new Community Resource and Training Center and Bart and Cherry Starr Museum on our New London campus, celebrating the groundbreaking with Cherry Starr herself in October 2021.

The most recent gift of \$1.5 million went to our Building Hope Capital Campaign. The company wanted \$500,000 to go toward the new Bart and Cherry Starr Museum. Through this long-standing support, Sentry has been alongside Rawhide through its evolution into what it has become today.

The relationship began when Rawhide's co-founder, Bart Starr, retired from Sentry's Board of Directors in 2007. Bart was Sentry's longest-serving board member and a lead director, dedicating 34 years to help shape Sentry's business and community efforts.

When Bart retired, Sentry made it's first donation to Rawhide in his honor.

Chairman of the Board, President and CEO of Sentry, Pete McPartland, met the honorable Bart Starr for the first time at an event, and quickly realized his ability to make anyone he interacted with feel special.



"I got to know what a real gentleman he was," McPartland said. "He really elevated everyone around him. Whatever bad habits you have, you want to fix them. You become more mindful of your grammar and how you carry yourself. His presence really brought out the best in others."

Meeting Bart Starr inspired McPartland to visit the Rawhide New London campus, and it left him in awe. He witnessed all that Rawhide offered to at-risk youth in the community, and he understood more deeply the importance of Sentry's partnership and support.

Young lives. Transformed.

To hurting and at-risk youth and their families, Rawhide is a resource for life-changing skills, training, counseling and therapies that offers residential and community-based services to equip youth—and their families—with the tools to build healthy relationships and behaviors that will help them overcome life's challenges.

We believe every person, regardless of where they come from, was created to be loved and respected, and is worthy of a healthy and fulfilling life.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Youth & Family Counseling

Our counseling services offer individual, group and family therapies for youth struggling with behavioral and mental health conditions in our residential program and in 8 counseling centers around the state. Therapists use a blend of styles and approaches (i.e., cognitive, behavioral, emotional, social and spiritual) with modalities, such as traditional, occupational, and equine-assisted therapies. Our counseling centers are located in Appleton, Fond du Lac, Green Bay, Greater Milwaukee, Neenah, New London and Shiocton. We also offer school-based therapy in over 30 Wisconsin schools.

CHAPS Equine-Assisted Therapy

For some youth, spending time with a horse can help break down barriers, allowing them to work through trauma and overcome behavioral and mental health struggles, such as anxiety, depression, trauma, ADHD, suicidal thoughts and more. Our CHAPS Equine-Assisted Therapy program creates a safe, judgment-free zone and builds trust—not just with the horse but also between youth and therapist. We offer equine-assisted therapy on our New London residential campus and at our counseling centers in Fond du Lac, Greater Milwaukee, Neenah and Shiocton locations. We partnered with BEAMING, Inc. in Neenah and MKE Urban Stables in Milwaukee to utilize their facilities so we can offer equine-assisted therapy to even more youth in our state.

Occupational Therapy

Through our comprehensive assessment process, youth can participate in occupational therapy services to help improve their cognitive, physical, sensory and motor skills, as well as their confidence and self-regulation.

Alumni Services

Alumni Services are provided to youth who have gone through Rawhide's programs. Services to alumni can include continued counseling, education support and many other types of assistance.

Young Life

Rawhide partners with Young Life, a Christian nonprofit organization that reaches out to nearly 1.5 million students in communities across the United States and around the world. Youth in our residential care program have the option to attend weekly meetings and activities. Young Life ministry staff model Jesus' work on earth by building bridges of authentic friendship with youth and meeting them exactly where they are at in life.

Residential Care

Rawhide's Residential Care Program benefits court-ordered, at-risk boys from 11 to 17 years old. Youth homes are operated and staffed by both resident and non-resident staff who are available to the youth 24 hours a day. The homes provide a positive, structured and supportive family-like environment. Outcomes focus on mental health, self-control, respect and responsibility. Youth attend Starr Academy and participate in group and individual therapies at our counseling center in New London.

Starr Academy


Starr Academy, located on the New London campus, is a fully accredited school through the Wisconsin Religious and Independent Schools Accreditation (WRISA). Starr Academy utilizes online learning to deliver individualized instruction to students based on their assessments and transcripts. Students are able to progress at their own rate while receiving academic and behavioral support from licensed teachers and youth development specialists.

Group Home

Our Group Home provides coaching, training and assistance to 13- to 17-year-old boys as they prepare to return back to their communities. The group home helps youth achieve their goals of life skills development and apply them through community-based social, spiritual, recreational, educational and employment opportunities. We also offer a variety of therapy techniques to help them overcome trauma. Youth attend school either on campus at Starr Academy or at a local high school. Additionally, they hold jobs in their local communities to help with their transition back to their families or independent living.

Job Training

Rawhide's Job Training program gives our youth opportunities to gain and maintain essential employment skills through curriculum-based education. The options include a specially designed, trauma-informed Career Development Class in partnership with Goodwill NCW and the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR); hands-on learning experiences in the culinary arts from the National Restaurant Association; or automotive technology from the Wisconsin and Auto Truck Dealers Association. Through these opportunities, youth gain practical, marketable skills and have an opportunity to receive industry certificates of completion, while also earning academic credit.



MEASURING TRANSFORMATION

At Rawhide, we have a very clear goal:

To transform the lives of the youth we serve. To help them through the darkness. To show them how to heal from their past and lead them toward a healthy, fulfilling life.

Transformation is the outcome we always aim for, and it's the promise we make to the youth and their families who come to us for help.



STORIES OF HOPE

Our youth are resilient, scarred warriors.

We serve hundreds of youth each year who are struggling with mental and behavioral issues that stem from abuse, neglect and trauma. Rawhide provides a safe environment to help nurture youth as they heal and grow from delicate seeds into sturdy trees.

These are some of their stories.

ANIKA

Anika is a seventh grader who loves math and wants to become a doctor someday. But she didn't always love school.

When she was about 3 years old, she and her mom moved to Wisconsin, leaving her dad in Illinois. The separation was difficult for her and she began suppressing her emotions. By the time she reached elementary school, she began expressing herself in violent ways at school, eventually getting expelled in the third grade.

"Being expelled affected my friendships," she said. "Some of them still don't talk to me to this day."

For the next few years, she began getting bullied by people at school who learned about her expulsion. The bullying left her feeling isolated and depressed. She stopped trusting others and struggled to create and maintain healthy relationships.

Eventually, she began going to therapy at Rawhide's Fond du Lac Counseling Center with her therapist Jeff. They played games together and swapped funny stories, but Anika struggled to talk about more serious topics. Jeff decided to introduce Anika to equine therapy, and it helped her recognize her feelings.

"Horses really bring out my true emotions, and they get the real subject of the story because they can tell how I feel deep inside," she said.

Anika connected with our horse, Cleo, who would nudge her when she was not being truthful or communicative in her sessions.

The more Anika began opening up, the more tools Jeff shared with her and the more she began to grow and heal.

"Therapy has really brought out the human in me," she said. "I have learned that it's okay to express your feelings, so they're not just bunched up inside of me and weighing me down," she said.



The most important lesson Anika has learned in therapy is how to love herself. Today, she is more confident and outgoing.

"Rawhide helped me come a long way and I very much appreciate it, more than words can describe," she said. "Therapy at Rawhide is one of the best things in my life."

MASON

Mason grew up witnessing domestic violence and substance abuse. When he was 8 years old, Mason's mom stabbed his dad to death. The police came in the middle of the night to take Mason and his siblings into child custody.

"The police woke me up and I didn't want to go with them, so I tried to hide in the closet," Mason said. "It was confusing and I was very angry."

Mason and his siblings went into foster care with family friends, Tim and Julie, and were eventually adopted.

"Being with them helped my growth as a teenager and a kid, getting over PTSD because of the traumatic experiences," Mason said. "They helped me through rough times. They took good care of me, and I appreciate that still today."



After all the trauma, neglect and abuse Mason experienced as a young boy, he was finally in a safe environment. His treatment team recommended therapy so Mason could heal from his past.

He started going to Rawhide's Appleton Counseling Center to see his therapist Lisa. Lisa worked closely with Mason to help him learn how to forgive his parents and the pain they had caused him. He and Lisa also worked on his anger management skills.

"The best advice I learned from Ms. Lisa is to forgive; otherwise, you'll be carrying that burden for a while and it will just destroy you," Mason said. "I also learned that forgiveness is not just words. You have to actually forgive them and show that in your actions."

Mason said Lisa also helped him understand how to work through some of his aggressiveness and instinct to fight others during confrontation. He spends a lot of his time participating in physical activities, such as working out or playing sports, to help him make better choices when he is stressed or triggered.

"Now when someone brings up my personal family stuff, I control myself and talk it out with someone safe," Mason said. "Rawhide helped me cope a lot and it got me through. You can be more open to them and they will help take that burden off your shoulders, and you'll feel much better."

ALLISON

Allison grew up with her mom and stepdad after her biological father went to jail. Over the years, she began building a solid and loving relationship with her stepdad, Roy.

"Once he came into my life, I just accepted him as my dad because he gave me all the love and support I needed in my life," Allison said.

When her stepdad also went to jail, Allison grieved the loss of his presence at home. She began to feel depressed and got behind in her school work. Allison also started getting bullied at school.

"I feel very hurt when other kids bully me; it really brings my mental health down," she said. "It just brings me down to a point where I just don't think I'm good enough."

She started seeing her therapist, Jeff, at Rawhide's Fond du Lac Counseling Center. Together, they worked through her struggles with depression, anxiety, self-worth and anger.

"Jeff has really been helping me through all these rough times," she said.

Allison was excited when she also began attending equine-assisted therapy sessions.

"I absolutely love equine therapy," Allison said. "Equine therapy taught me that having a horse is a lot of work and that has helped me learn you can't control what other people are feeling."

She paired up with the horse, Dolly. Through fun activities and deep conversations, Allison began to notice her mental and physical health were improving. She was also less fearful and more trusting of those around her.

"Before I started these sessions with Jeff and Dolly, I thought everyone was out to hurt me," she said. "Now I can go out in public and not worry about someone trying to hurt me or worrying about friends abandoning me."

It took Allison years of fighting her depression alone before she finally accepted help.

"It's horrible fighting your mental illness alone," she said. "I learned the hard way. So I want people to know that Rawhide changed my life and it could possibly help others."

DONTAE

Dontae grew up without a father, and was in and out of homelessness before he came to Rawhide. He longed for a male presence in his life and took on the responsibility to take care of his family. All of this led him down a path of bad choices until he was sent to Rawhide for a second chance.

"I worried about what was coming today, not tomorrow," he said.

At Rawhide, he struggled being pulled away from his family and not being there to protect or provide for them. Over time, Dontae began to connect with staff and work through some of his mental and behavioral health issues, such as managing his anger and depression.

His houseparents, Mike and Lisa, were two of the staff members he was especially close with who helped guide him during his time at Rawhide.

Living Unit Coordinator, Ryan, was like a big brother to Dontae, talking through his struggles together and calming him down when he was agitated.

Donate enjoyed being part of the

Rawhide All-Starrs basketball team because it taught him how to work on his fundamental strength and learn to get along with other people in a team setting.

He also participated in equine-assisted therapy, connecting quickly to our one-eyed, sweetheart horse Memphis. Together, they walked through activities and games while Dontae learned coping skills to heal from his past.

"I am most grateful for Rawhide giving me a chance and helping me grow," he said.

Dontae knew he wanted to be able to care for his family when he completed his Rawhide program, so he joined the job training career development class. This course taught him how to find and keep a job. He discovered skills he never knew he had that could go on his resume.

"My greatest accomplishment was discharging successfully from the Rawhide program," he said. "It felt good to be going home knowing I grew as a person."

Back home, he is a sophomore in high school and works part-time at Kwik Trip to help his family and build his future. In five years, Dontae hopes to attend school to become a welder. He also hopes he is still working on living in the present moment.

EVER

Rawhide alumni, Ever, experienced a lot of loss in his family at such a young age. This frequency and level of trauma over time led Ever down a negative path.

"My life was different after my losses, and I didn't really care for a lot in those days," Ever said.

Soon he began surrounding himself with the wrong crowd and began to make poor choices. He was expelled from school and said people began to look at him as a "bad kid," which only made him struggle more to love himself.

"Years passed and I kept being the worst version of myself," he said.

Eventually, Ever found himself at Rawhide, where he lived for 10 months as he completed residential treatment. He went to school at Starr Academy, attended therapy and grew his support system with the staff.

"Rawhide changed my mentality and life for the better," Ever said. "I met some amazing people who changed my life!"

Thanks to the support and safety from the staff, he began to feel more comfortable opening up to them. He learned about self-control, responsibility, respect, determination, leadership and empathy.

"Many people at Rawhide showed me love and affection, which I had begun to believe I wasn't worthy of anymore," he said.

Ever worked hard to become a better person each day. He was also a leader to some of the other youth. He set a good example for the others to show they could heal and complete their program, too.



His biological family also took part in his treatment. They visited with Ever every other week to help improve their relationships. Today, Ever lives with his foster family, attends school to earn his high school diploma, and attends a church to rebuild his connection with God.

"There have been hiccups and difficulties in my new start, but you can't let those keep you down," Ever said. "I'm at a better point in my life than I've been in years and I hope to continue to succeed in my life and get better each day. For this, I thank Rawhide and God for a second chance that everyone deserves."
